It was at ETH Zurich that Albert Einstein laid down the foundations for his life's work. He studied here and later taught as a professor of theoretical physics. Besides, it was at ETH Zurich where he met his first wife, Mileva Marić, a fellow student. Albert Einstein lived in Zurich for eight years and became a citizen of the city in 1901.
